COVID-19 Pandemic Disaster Relief

Lawrence County Department of Job and Family Services will make available assistance to families affected by this health crisis. The purpose of this program is to offer assistance to families who have been financially impacted by a layoff or reduced work hours due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Eligible Services:

A one-time payment of \$300.00 per TANF eligible household.

Eligibility:

Eligibility will be assessed through self-attestation of the applicant. The program is limited TANF-eligible families who attest income to be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

Family is defined in federal and state law and regulations as follows: a minor child who resides with a parent, specific relate, legal guardian or legal custodian (a child may be temporarily absent from the home provided certain requirements are met); a pregnant individual with no other children; or a non-custodial parent who lives in the state, but does not reside with his/her minor child(ren).

Documentation:

A statement from employer detailing that due to the COVID-19 pandemic either the following has occurred:

- 1. Loss of job
- 2. Reduction in hours

If employer is/has closed due to COVID-19 the last received paystub will be accepted.
